WHAT IS A BEQUEST?

A bequest is a gift directed to McMaster University, specified according to your wishes through a provision in your will. Funds can be bequeathed as a specific dollar amount or asset, or as a percentage of the residue.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- As with any charitable donation, you may direct your gift to the area that is the most meaningful for you and you may also provide an unrestricted donation to support the University's greatest needs.
- A bequest intention is revocable and can be changed if your personal or financial circumstances change.
- An estate can often provide a much larger gift than the donor can afford during life. With a little planning, you may be able to leave a significant legacy for generations to come.
- A bequest gift is eligible for a charitable tax receipt that can be applied to the final two income tax returns, which will reduce the overall tax burden on your estate.
- You can make a provision in your will to donate publicly listed securities, which could result in significant tax savings for your estate, as it will be exempt from the capital gains tax.
- Bequests are important sources of future income and/or assets for McMaster University and knowledge of these generous provisions allows the University to plan ahead for years to come.
